The Season Schedule:

The season will start in early May. We'll post the season schedule on the website as soon as we can. We will not schedule any games on the long weekends. Once the schedule is made, you will be notified by email and can download it from the website.

Rosters, Insurance Etc:

By the end of April, you will be receiving your team roster by email. This has the name and phone number of each person on your team. If you haven't received this information by two weeks prior to your season opener, please contact us.

Our insurance coverage requires that each player have soccer cleats (not runners) and shin guards for every game. It is imperative that you have your equipment for each game or you will not be allowed to play.
